


## **BLOOD PRESSURE FORM**

0a) Date of Collection
Instructions: This form should be completed during the participant's clinic visit.
Reminder: Participant Safety Guidelines
If the average blood pressure is $\geq$ 200mmHg systolic or $\geq$ 120 mmHg diastolic, or $\leq$ 100mmHg systolic or $\leq$ 60mmHg diastolic the coordinator should remove the cuff and reposition per protocol then re-measure the blood pressure.
If after the re-measure the average blood pressure is still $\geq$ 200mmHg systolic or $\geq$ 120 mmHg diastolic, or $\leq$ 100mmHg systolic or $\leq$ 60mmHg diastolic the coordinator closes out the data entry screen, interrupts the visit and notifies the supervisor immediately.
If the average heart rate $\geq$ 100bpm or $\leq$ 60bpm the coordinator should remove the cuff and reposition per the protocol if using a digital mechanism. If taking a radial pulse, the coordinator should take the pulse again counting the beats per minute for a full 60 seconds.
If after the re-measure the average heart rate is still $\geq$ 100bpm or $\leq$ 60bpm the coordinator closes out the data entry screen, interrupts the examination and notifies the supervisor immediately.
